

#### **BUILDING UPDATE**

We have received a scope of work and a quote for the engineering drawings for the expansion and updates of the foyer. We will also add an ADA family bathroom where the coat room is currently. After reviewing and accepting the drawings we will move forward with the General Contractor we have retained.

Additionally, work will start in the next week on the removal of the tile floor in the old sanctuary and side rooms which will take two weeks to complete. Carpet squares will replace the tile for easy care and replacement.

We are meeting with several heating and air conditioning contractors to obtain bids for the replacement of the unit in the old sanctuary to be installed this fall. It is also our intent to replace the flooring in the hallways upon the completion of the renovation of the foyer.

#### SPIRIT OF SILAS MEMORIAL EVENT

On the bulletin board, across from the church office, is a flyer about the Spirit of Silas event, (September 30<sup>th</sup>), showing that this year's event is NOT simply a motorcycle fun(d) run. We have been working hard to provide an afternoon/evening of family friendly events. My reasoning for insisting on that concept was that **a**: Silas was only 16 when he passed. He was a kid; **b**: Silas' friends would be only about 18 now. Very few would be of an age they could frequent the "bar scene"; and **c**: Many of Silas' friends, and our family's friends, who might want to participate, are church-going folks who might not be interested in 1 - the Motorcycle run or 2 - staying out late on a Saturday night to listen to the bands!

My point is, I want you to know about the many events - including the auction - that will be taking place at TIMBUKTU that day...AND that we need help! ALSO - all proceeds go to the charity that Silas himself chose before he died: Alex's Lemonade Stand Foundation (they raise awareness of all childhood cancer, and most importantly fund research for a cure of childhood cancer).

- **First** we need 3 or 4 volunteers to help load up tables and chairs from the fellowship hall that morning about 8am, to take to the event site by about 9am, and follow the trailer out there to help set them up for the auction and registration tables. 1-1/2 to 2 hour commitment.
- **Second** we need 3 or 4 volunteers to help load up tables and chairs at the site, following the auction about 8pm, to bring back to the church and set them back up in the fellowship hall for Sunday School class, and store/re-stack the others. Again, 1-1/2 to 2 hour commitment.
- **Third** we need donations for auction items or baskets. These can be small or large. This would be an ideal opportunity for small groups! I can provide receipts for the items or baskets. Individuals may also make monetary donations if desired. All donations are tax deductible, as well. The tax i.d. for those purposes is 56-2496146. Items or baskets may be given to me at church, or dropped off at my house. I can arrange for our auction chairman to pick them up as well. I can give ideas, if needed, or let you know what we already have.
